

Course Details

FA4 Emergency First Aid Paediatric Course

This course consists of one day's training in Emergency Care Procedures designed to give the student a basic knowledge in the essential skills of paediatric patient care. The course meets the recommendations of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 issued by the Health & Safety Executive. It is delivered in accordance with the Approved Code of Practice L74 for training of candidates in first aid working with young children and or adults

Selection of Suitable Candidates

Any member of an organisation or company who is likely to find themselves taking charge of a first aid emergency or assisting a qualified First Aider.

Content

This course covers the basic essentials required to provide emergency care to patients of all ages but particularly children and babies.

Candidates will receive training in a range of first aid skills including:

- The ability to act safely and effectively when an accident or emergency occurs
- The treatment and priorities of care for an unconscious patient
- The recognition of cardiac arrest and delivery of cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- The ability to safely and promptly treat a patient who is bleeding
- The ability to safely and promptly treat a patient who is choking
- The ability to safely and promptly treat a patient who is bleeding
- The ability to safely and promptly treat a child who is 'unwell'
- The keeping of simple records following an accident at work

The course follows a syllabus laid down by the Dimension-People Safe family of first aid training systems which utilises the following training methods:

- Video/DVD segments to convey essential information
- Hands on practice in groups
- Positive coaching from approved Instructors with a maximum group size of 12 students
- Up-to-date medical information presented in a stress-free learning environment
- Opportunity for self appraisal and completion of a class evaluation

Certification

Candidates who successfully complete the course will be awarded a certificate. The qualification is valid for three years.
