 - Sources of fuel
 - Sources of oxygen
 - Facilitating Evacuation

This programme cover all of the information contained in the basic course plus considering the specific role of the Fire Warden/Marshall including conducting risk assessments and facilitating evacuation.

Venue requirements

Training room with adequate space and blackout facility.

Ideally data projector and television/video player

Projection screen

The practical risk assessment requires participants to have access to other parts of the training venue/site
