

## **Fire Safety Awareness and Fire Warden FO5 Ref FWF**

**Duration** – 4 - 6 hrs

This is a theory and practical course designed for members of staff with the designated role of Fire Warden or Fire Marshall. It is a balance of video and 'Powerpoint' Presentation. Participants are awarded a successful completion or attendance certificate

### **Content**

- Methods of heat travel
- Methods of extinction
- Classes of Fire
- Portable Fire Fighting equipment
- Operation and use of Fire Extinguishers
- Raising the alarm
- Signage
- The role of the Fire Warden
- Evacuation
- Conducting Risk Assessments
  - Sources of ignition
  - Sources of fuel
  - Sources of oxygen
  - Facilitating Evacuation

This programme covers all of the information contained in the basic course plus considering the specific role of the Fire Warden/Marshall including conducting risk assessments and facilitating evacuation. Students will have the opportunity to extinguish a number of real fire using portable fire extinguishers

### **Venue requirements**

Training room with adequate space and blackout facility.

Ideally data projector and television/video player

Projection screen

A large open area away from buildings etc in which fires can be lit\*

Fires are lit using a range of fuels and are contained within metal drums

**NB.** A 'Hot Working Permit' may be required for this activity
